

## Answers to Practice Exercises for Chapter 14 – Four Rules for Decimals

### Set A - Question 10

$$\begin{array}{r} 165 \\ \times 2 \\ \hline 330 \end{array}$$

$$165 \times 2 = 330$$

16.5 x 0.02 has 3 decimal places altogether so  $16.5 \times 0.02 = 0.330$ .

You can then drop the trailing zero:  $16.5 \times 0.02 = 0.33$
