

## Answers to Practice Exercises for Chapter 7 – The Four Rules for Larger Numbers

### Set A - Question 3

Lay it out like this.

$$\begin{array}{r} 37 \\ 22 \\ 18 \\ 29 \\ 19 \\ 18 \\ \hline \hline \end{array}$$

First add the units column:  $7 + 2 + 8 + 9 + 9 + 8 = 43$ , write down the 3 and carry the 4 into the tens column.

$$\begin{array}{r} 37 \\ 22 \\ 18 \\ 29 \\ 19 \\ 18 \\ \hline 3 \\ \hline 4 \end{array}$$

Now add the tens column,  $3 + 2 + 1 + 2 + 1 + 1 +$  the carried  $4 = 14$ . There are no hundreds to add except the carried 1 so write 14 down.

$$\begin{array}{r} 37 \\ 22 \\ 18 \\ 29 \\ 19 \\ 18 \\ \hline 143 \\ \hline 4 \end{array}$$
